



WASTE TOOL

INDICATOR 1:

A company's waste output consists of everything deemed no longer of any use to the company and therefore removed from the company (buildings and private land). Indicator 1 is a quantitative measure of waste output related to the effectiveness of company operations, with the target being to achieve zero waste output. The more efficient production processes are, the lower waste output becomes - and the easier it becomes to achieve this target. As far as possible, any remaining waste output should be green, i.e. it can all be reused, recycled or is biodegradable.

Target level 1 is reached when a company's total waste output is at least 25% reused, recycled or biodegradable.

Target level 2 is reached when a company's total waste output is at least 50% reused, recycled or biodegradable.

Target level 3 is reached when a company's total waste output is at least 75% reused, recycled or biodegradable.

Target level 4 is reached when a company's total waste output is removed from the company as separate materials for reuse by another company.
