INDICATOR 1:

This indicator is used for assessing the extent to which a company operates in an energy-neutral way (i.e. regarding both electricity and fuel).

The lower a company's energy consumption is, the easier it is for it to achieve energy neutrality.

As far as possible, any remaining energy should be green. A company acquiring residual heat from another company or a third-party can enter this as green energy.

Target level 1 is reached when a company is 25% energy-neutral, i.e. when the total green energy and heat ENTERING the company covers at least 25% of total energy requirements.

Target level 2 is reached when a company is 50% energy-neutral, i.e. when the total green energy and heat ENTERING the company covers at least 50% of total energy requirements.

Target level 3 is reached when a company is 75% energy-neutral, i.e. when the total green energy and heat ENTERING the company covers at least 75% of total energy requirements.

Target level 4 is reached when a company is 100% energy-neutral, i.e. when the total green energy and heat ENTERING the company covers 100% of total energy requirements.
